The current hardcover listing for **Essentials of Ophthalmic Lens Finishing** is the strongest route in the sampled market. It sits far below the bookseller and campus-store prices that were sampled. For a technical optics and dispensing reference, that makes the current hardcover an easy ownership choice.
