If you only need the buying answer

The current new print listing is **\$70.98**, which is essentially tied with 180-day digital at **\$72.80** and well below lifetime digital at **\$112.00** and the sampled used print route at **\$141.81**. That makes this a strong print-ownership case. If you need the book at all, current print is one of the best clean values in the visible market.
