## If you only need the buying answer

The current hardcover listing for **Milady Advanced Esthetics** is the strongest ownership route in the sampled market. It is well below the sampled retail hardcover prices and even below the quoted rental references. For a professional reference book in advanced esthetics, that makes the current hardcover an unusually easy recommendation.
