If you only need the buying answer, this is a strong hardcover-ownership case. The current Merybook hardcover is below the sampled rental price, below the sampled eText price, and far below the broader hardcover market, so print is the better value if you expect to revisit bacterial genetics after one course.

The numbers here are unusually favorable to ownership. The current hardcover is not just lower than the rest of the print market. It is also lower than rental and lower than the sampled eTextbook route. That makes print the easier choice for anyone who expects this book to remain useful in later microbiology or genetics work.

What this book actually teaches

Snyder and Champness Molecular Genetics of Bacteria matters because bacterial genetics is learned by circling back. Mutation, recombination, regulation, mobile elements, and genome-level thinking rarely make perfect sense on the first pass. A strong text in this area gives students a stable framework they can return to as the mechanisms begin to fit together.

That is why ownership has real academic value here. Students often revisit diagrams, pathways, and conceptual distinctions when later microbiology, molecular biology, or

infectious-disease work starts asking more from them. A durable hardcover supports that kind of re-reading better than a short-term access window.

Who should buy hardcover and who should not

Buy hardcover if you are in microbiology, genetics, or biomedical study and expect bacterial genetics to keep resurfacing. At the current prices, hardcover is the strongest value route.

There is not much reason to choose rental or eText here unless you strongly prefer temporary digital reading. On both value and reuse, print already wins.
